When is the camp?

SLSP Toronto runs for 7 weeks every summer, Monday to Friday from 9am to 3pm. Check our website at www.silentvoice.ca to find out this year's dates.

Where is SLSP?

SLSP currently has one location, usually at a local school within the City of Toronto. Please contact slsp@silentvoice.ca to get more information on this year's location.

What about Transportation?

For an additional fee, buses can transport the campers safely from their homes (or a nearby pick-up point) to the camp site in the morning and back home in the afternoon. Bus routes change weekly. Pick-up and drop-off times may change with bus routes. We cannot guarantee transportation for all children.

What does the camp cost?

\$75 per child per week (\$35 for siblings)

\$75 per child per week for Transportation (no Payment discounts for siblings)

Payment is due with the registration package either by post dated cheques or VISA. An additional \$10 is required for each t-shirt. Subsidies are available.
