

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY Camp Counsellor (in-person) Milton (12 positions) & Toronto (10 positions)

The primary responsibilities required for this position include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Promoting and maintaining a safe, inclusive, and healthy camp experience for all campers and staff.
- 2. Fostering positive relationships among campers and serving as a mentor and role model.
- 3. Supervising campers during daily routines, meals, and outings.
- 4. Promoting teamwork, personal growth, and fun through activities and interactions.
- 5. Leading recreational activities for campers and collaborating with camp staff to provide engaging programming.
- 6. Demonstrating excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- 7. Ensuring the safety and well-being of all campers.
- 8. Building relationships with all campers by showing compassion, empathy and understanding.
- 9. Providing basic first aid as needed to campers.
- 10. Participating in training workshops held prior to camp.
- 11. Reporting to the Camp Coordinator; and,
- 12. Performing other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Enthusiasm for working with children and youth.
- Self-starter, team player, ability to multitask, creative.
- Ability to maintain a safe and inclusive environment for all campers.
- Patience, empathy, and a positive attitude.
- Ability to uphold camp policies and procedures.
- Fluent in ASL.
- Knowledgeable and respectful of Deaf culture.

Canada Summer Jobs Candidate Criteria:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment*;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment; and,
- have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.

*The youth must be 15-30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period. The youth may have a birthday and become 31 years of age during the employment period.
